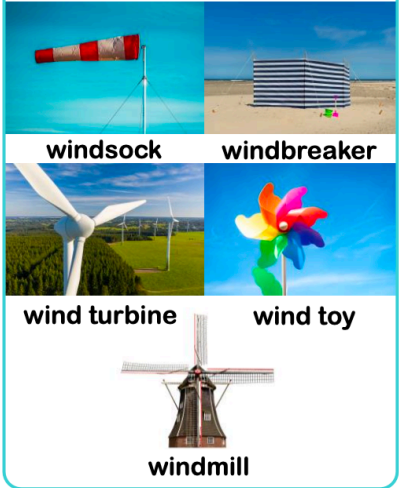

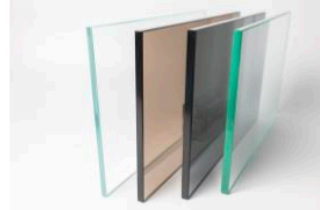

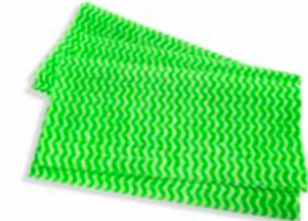
## Key Vocabulary
