Sounds like 'sa va'

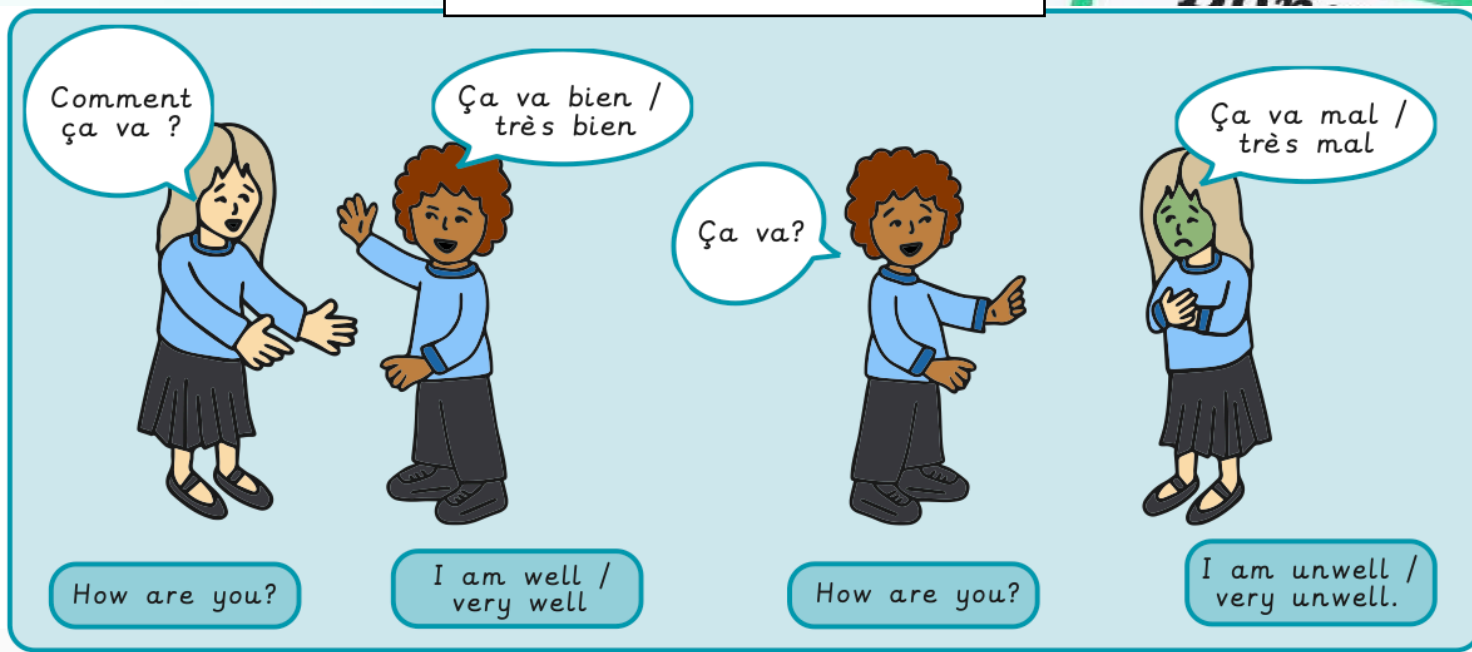
