The currency in France is the Euro - the euro symbol is €

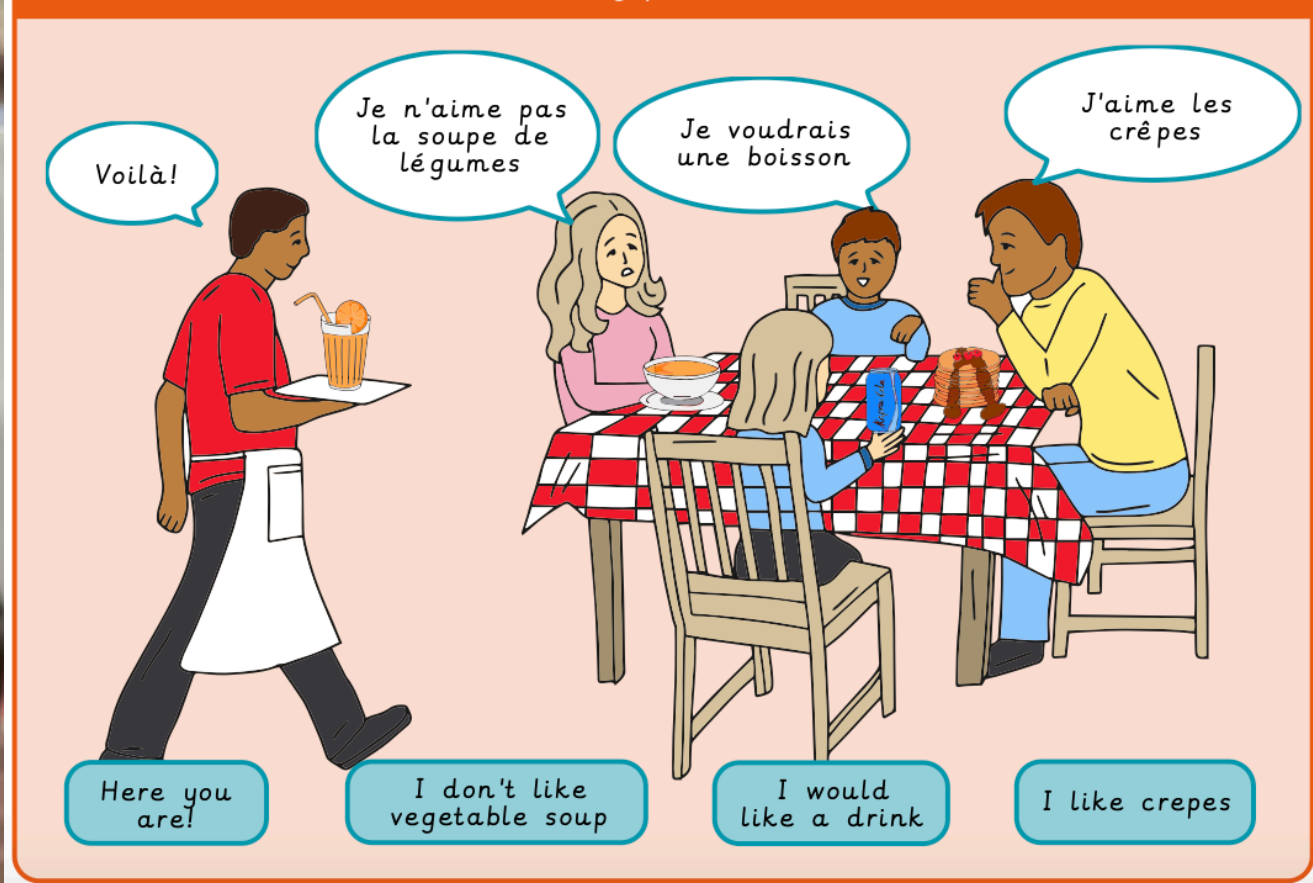
Cognates:
