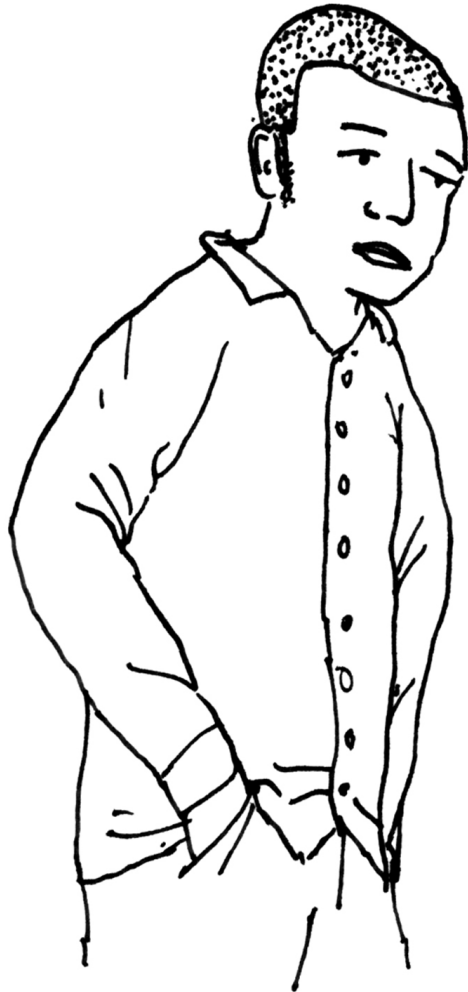
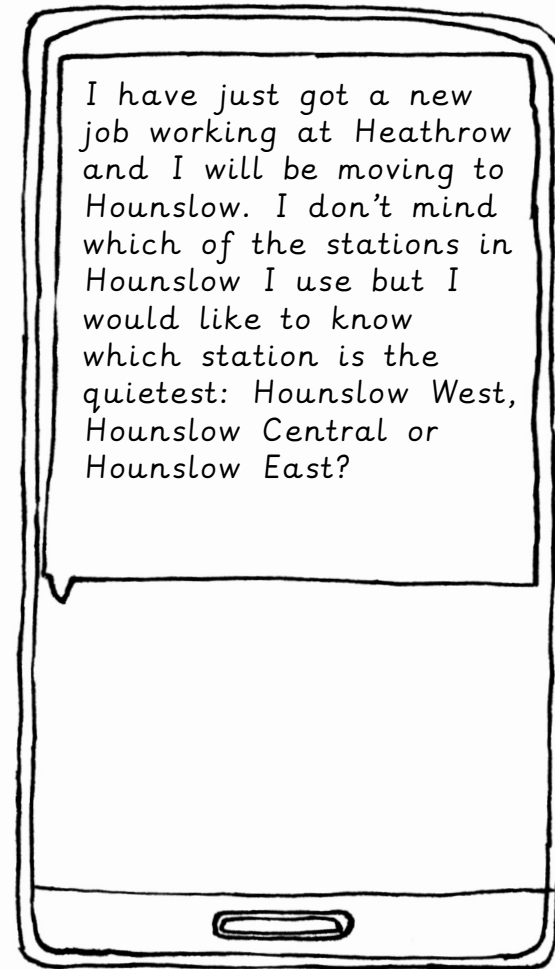


Commuter one

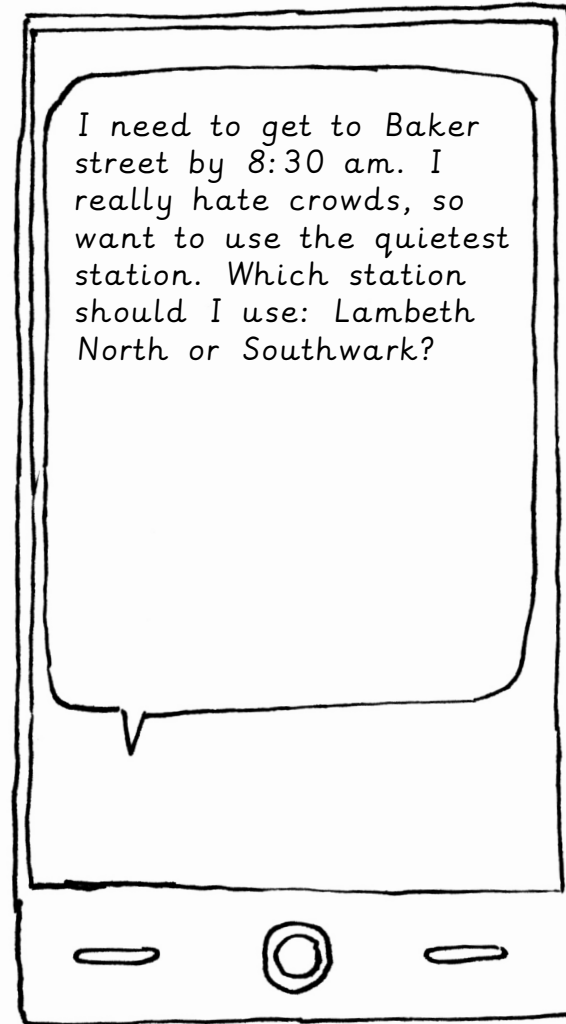
