This Book Week we are asking our pupils, parents, Governors and wider school community to donate new books to re-launch our library. Since the school library was opened in March 2012 we have not fully restocked titles and we have wholly operated on donations of used books. We would like to use this Book Week to start a book donation scheme to extend the titles in the library by offering classic titles as well as newer titles which have been published since the library was opened.

Every book donated will have a donation label stuck inside with the name of the donor printed on. This means that the books will remain in the library for years to come as the pupils move through school.
